



Position description Part-timer

There are six part-time positions on the Linnaeus union board. To apply for these, you do not need to take a study break; it is a role you can have alongside your studies. As a board member, you will attend board meetings and are expected to participate in one of the union's working groups, which work on various topics, including student welfare or educational matters. You will also represent the union in different projects and events throughout the year. Two of the six part-time members are also part of the EUniWell committee, one in Kalmar and one in Växjö. If you are particularly passionate about international issues, make sure to mention this in your application.

In your role as a part-time board member, you will support the work of the executive team, including participating in working groups and serving as a student representative in university committees. As a part-time board member, you may work on issues such as educational quality or internationalization, but you will also have the opportunity to run your own projects. Examples of projects that part-time members have been involved in or led include Easter egg hunts, membership benefits, the main student protection representative, and the establishment of a student union house in Kalmar.

The union also holds additional internal meetings, which you, as a part-time board member, are more than welcome to attend, as this helps you better understand the overall work of the union.

For this position, you will receive compensation every month.
