

Terms and conditions of membership



1 Introduction

1.1 Purpose

The purpose of this document is to clarify the terms and conditions for becoming and being a member of Linnaeus Union. By becoming a member of Linnékåren, you accept these terms.

1.2 Student ID

You must obtain your own student ID to supplement your membership. Linnaeus Union recommends Studentkortet (STUK).

2 Membership

This section explains the requirements for different types of membership, how to become a member, and the duration of membership.

2.1 Membership Categories

Linnaeus Union's membership is divided into two categories: regular membership and supporting membership.

2.2 Membership Qualifications

2.2.1 Regular Membership

Only those registered as students or doctoral candidates at Linnaeus University are eligible for regular membership.

2.2.2 Support membership

Anyone who wants to support Linnaeus Union's activities can become a support member.

2.3 Membership Duration

2.3.1 Regular Membership

The regular membership is valid per semester and can be purchased for one or two semesters at a time.

Membership for the autumn semester runs from two weeks before the start of the autumn semester until the last day of the semester. Membership for the spring semester runs from two weeks before the start of the spring semester until the last day of the semester. This is in accordance with the decision made at board meeting 6, §142, academic year 2023/2024.

2.3.2 Support Membership

Valid on a yearly basis.

3 Membership Fee

The membership fee is determined at the annual meeting each year.

3.1 Refund Policy

As a main rule, purchased memberships are non-refundable.

5 Termination of Membership

5.1 By the Member

You can resign from Linnaeus Union at any time by submitting a written request to the board via email: president@linnek.se.

As a main rule, purchased memberships are non-refundable.

5.2 By the Student Union

The board may exclude a member who has deliberately acted against the union's purpose, values, or otherwise worked against the organisation.
